Purpose/Role

The Tutor Escort will work under the direct supervision of the Classroom Teacher to carry out the objectives of the student's individual plan. The Tutor Escort's job varies according to the special needs of the student to whom he/she has been assigned.

Duties:

- * Implement remedial programs for student requiring extra help
- * Facilitate student individually and in groups, using various teaching methods such as discussion, demonstrations, hands on learning activities, and technological aids (smart boards, computers)
- * Keep a detailed log book of student progress
- * Participate in IPRCs and IEPs
- * Find and practice creative ways to deal with challenging situations
- * Provide direct classroom and behavior management and techniques to enhance positive student interaction and learning
- * Attend professional meetings, educational conferences, and teacher training workshops in order to maintain and improve professional growth and development
- * Assist with coordinating extracurricular activities such as clubs, fund raising and academic contests (volunteering where needed in cultural and sporting activities)
