Wasauksing First Nation Student Employment Program 2019 JOB POSTING

Wasauksing First Nation is now seeking applicants for the Student Employment Program 2019. Applications are now being accepted for the following positions:

Childcare Worker (x2)

- provide assistance to the teachers of the Little Eagle Childcare Centre in the delivery of program and service
- work with children between the ages of 18 months to 12 years old.

Maintenance Worker (x2)

- assist in the janitorial services to any Wasauksing First Nation building (wash floors, wash windows, empty garbage cans)
- assist in the maintenance of grounds around community buildings

Communications Support (x1)

- assist communications staff in preparing, providing and coordination of communication initiatives
- provide general office support to the communications and administration staff of Wasauksing First Nation (computer input, filing, photocopying, etc.)
- answer the administration telephone in any of the reception areas (central administration, school, Health Station, or Adult Learning Centre)

To qualify for the Student Employment Program 2019, an individual must meet the following criteria:

- Students must be 15 and 30 years of age at the time of hiring;
- Students must have been registered as full-time students in the previous academic year, and intending to return to school on a full-time basis in the next academic year;
- Be students in a secondary, post-secondary, vocational or technical program, but not attending full time classes while participating in their placement;
- Be legally entitled to work in Canada according to relevant provincial/territorial legislation and regulations;
- Not hold another full time (30 hours or more) summer job.

START DATE: Tuesday, July 2, 2019

END DATE: Friday, August 30, 2019

HOURS OF WORK: 40 Hours per week/shift work and weekends

RATE OF PAY: \$14.00/hour
Dependent upon academic level achieved and placement duties
