The following are available resources for students and families to utilize during this time.

Wasauksing Kinomaugewgamik

The staff at Wasauksing Kinomaugewgamik have been working to develop an extensive set of additional activities that can be completed at home which are individualized according to the students' age and learning levels.

- We are reaching out directly to families in order to share these suggestions with you. We have updated our contact list in order to maintain regular communication with families.
- Wasauksing Kinomaugewgamik has an annual subscription to Reading A - Z, and each classroom also has access to Epic! books. Your child's teacher will provide you with login information and a password
