

WASAUKSING FIRST NATION
TEMPORARY EMERGENCY RESPONSE LAW AMENDING LAW

WHEREAS the Council of the Wasauksing First Nation enacted the *Wasauksing First Nation Temporary Emergency Response Law* on March 24, 2020 in order to respond to serious emergencies on Wasauksing Lands in a timely and efficient manner, as necessary to protect the health, safety and security of Wasauksing First Nation and its Citizens and residents;


WHEREAS the Council of Wasauksing First Nation has determined that additional emergency orders may be required to curb the spread of infectious diseases and protect the health and safety of Citizens and residents,

NOW THEREFORE the Chief and Council of the Wasauksing First Nation hereby enacts as follows.

1. The Wasauksing First Nation Temporary Emergency Response Law is amended by adding the following paragraph and sub-paragraphs at section 3.1:
 - (l) the imposition of measures designed to prevent and reduce the transmission of infectious diseases and hazardous agents on Wasauksing Lands, including but not limited to
 - i. quarantine and self-isolation restrictions and requirements for individuals and public and private places and spaces,
 - ii. restrictions and prohibitions on group gatherings,
 - iii. requirements for individuals to maintain certain safe distances from one another and to avoid physical contact, and
 - iv. any further measures, orders, restrictions and requirements deemed necessary to prevent or reduce the transmission of infectious diseases and hazardous agents by Council or any person designated by Council in accordance with paragraph 2.2(c).
2. For clarity, the Wasauksing First Nation Temporary Emergency Response Law remains in full force and effect, unaltered except as specifically set out in this Law.
3. This Amending Law comes into force and effect on the date that it is enacted by Council of Wasauksing First Nation.


