

Student Transportation to Parry Sound High School – September, 2020

Due to concerns regarding COVID-19, transportation arrangements for students who attend Parry Sound High School will need to be modified, at least for the start of the school year.

Parents are strongly encouraged to make their own transportation arrangements.

Should transportation be provided by Wasauksing First Nation, several protocols will be implemented to minimize the risk to students and the driver.

- The option to ride the school bus will be limited to students of Parry Sound High School only.
- Students (unless living in the same household) will not be permitted to share a seat with any other student.
- The school bus may be required to make multiple trips, to limit the number of passengers on board. If such plans are instituted, you will be contacted with more information as to pick up/drop off times, and additional route information.
- Buses will be thoroughly cleaned after each run.
- All students and the driver (and bus monitor, if available) will be required to wear a mask at all times. Students must sit in an assigned seat. Daily attendance records of the students riding the bus each morning and afternoon will be maintained, to assist with contact tracing, should it be required.

Please contact the Education Department (education@wasauksing.ca) to complete a transportation request, so that routes can be modified and seating plans developed to accommodate the students who will require transportation, ***if bussing is available.***
