You will be a valued member of the primary/home and community health-care team in the Wasauksing First Nation, who will on a daily schedule at the end of the workday, clean; sanitize and disinfect key areas within the Health Centre.

Applicants ideally would have a work history that includes industrial cleaning and/or certification and be willing to work on a daily basis, coming in from 3pm-5pm to maintain a daily schedule of daily disinfection and sanitization of the work areas. This will provide for the health centre additional cleaning that will add the cleaning already performed by the maintenance staff. This is to ensure, high level of disinfection during the 4<sup>th</sup> Wave of the COVID-19 Pandemic. The successful candidate will be physically capable to perform assigned duties of a custodian (ie able to lift up to 50lbs; stand for extended periods of time etc.)
