Please note the following information, to assist us with school entry on our first day of classes:

Students can be dropped off at Wasauksing Kinomaugewgamik, from 8:30 – 8:45 a.m.

School day: 8:45 a.m. – 3:15 p.m.

Nutrition breaks will take place at 10:40 a.m. and 1:00 p.m.

We will continue to be screening every person who enters our facility. We will have teachers on duty at 8:30, who will ensure that all children have completed a COVID screening checklist.

Families will now have the option to complete an online screening form. Only one form needs to be completed for your children unless there is different information for each child.

Once you have completed the online screening tool you must email the completed results to schoolscreening@wasauksing.ca. If you would prefer to complete a paper copy of the screening form, you can complete it when you drop your children off at the school or you can print the screening form found on our WFN website. Printed copies will also be sent home with your students on the first day. Again, only one form needs to be completed per household.

Students in Grades 1 – 8 will be required to wear masks at all times while indoors (except while eating or drinking). We encourage Kindergarten students to wear masks as well, particularly when physical distancing cannot be achieved.
